This fall 14 of our young adults are attending high-school upgrading courses or a college/university program largely through the support of Marco Sotres and our new Post-secondary program. Our housing ministry recently had two residents reach their 1-year anniversary of living in the home. We are very thankful for house parents Ben and Deirdre Stevens and their new respite

support Linette Schut for creating such a loving home environment. Our community space and monthly events are hosted by Sarah Hartung who returned from maternity leave in July. This fall we look forward to games nights, holiday dinners and pumkin carving. The newest addition to our team is Darrell Bedford, our part-time Sunday Coordinator. He will be overseeing rides to church and Sunday afternoons at The House and is passionate about sharing the love of Jesus in a fun filled environment.
