"Helping with the camps was obviously the most impactful to me, because I could really connect with the youth. The thing that stood out to me was just the connection they have with each other. They would always look out and be there for each other even when it was hard. At the end of the day, they had each other's backs - which is such a cool thing to see. I think being a part of the community at Inner Hope models that for them



and camp definitely strengthened their bonds.

The other thing that I really loved was learning more about Indigenous culture. I had lots of talks with John and Jenn during the Boundless Camping Trip. I gained so much more perspective, which I'm going to bring home with me.

- 2 young adults worked at Camp Qwanoes and 8 youth completed LEADERSHIP TRAINING


